## General information

### **Enrollment**

### **Connections airport/Palermo**

#### *By bus*

The bus of the Prestia and Comandè company leaves from the airport to the center leaves every 30 minutes (8 – 8.30 – 9.00 – 9.30 ecc.).

It takes about 45 minutes /1 hour to get to the last stop: Central train station (Piazza Giulio Cesare).

The price of the one way ticket is 6.30 €, including the return is 11 €.

You find the bus station at the exit of the airport on the right.

#### *By taxi sharing*

Alternatively, you can take the taxi sharing, the cost is 7 € and the journey lasts about 35/45 minutes.

You can find the cabs are at the exit on the right of the terminal. They leave as soon as they are full.

You can ask the driver to drop you off along the route. If you have to go in a place of the city out from the normal path the cost is 10 €. To come back to the airport you can book the taxi sharing 2 days in advance at the cost of 10 €. Tel. +39 331 429 6956.

#### *By train*

Train station is located downstairs in the airport. The cost of the ticket is 5.90 €.

To reach the Central train station (Piazza Giulio Cesare) takes more than an hour.

#### *By taxi*

You find taxis just in front the exit of the terminal. The cost of a normal taxi is around 40-45 €.

### **Work places**

From February 24<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> the venue of all the activities will be the Law Department of the University of Palermo, Via Maqueda, 172, 90133 Palermo, Italy.

On February 28<sup>th</sup> the activity will be in “Istituto di Formazione Politica Pedro Arrupe”, Via Franz Lehar, 6 – Palermo. From there we will move to visit other neighborhoods where Arrupe Institute carries out research-actions.

To reach the Istituto Arrupe from historic center you can take the bus n. 103 from via Roma-Vucciria to Piazza Ziino (ticket 1.60 €). Frequency: every 30 minutes and it takes 40 minutes. By walking you need about one hour.

### **Accommodation**

The Law Department of the University of Palermo is located in the historic center, where we suggest you to look for accommodation.

From February 24th to 27th we will have lunches in Moltivolti. We chose this place because it expresses values and topics of the meeting and Trans.making project.

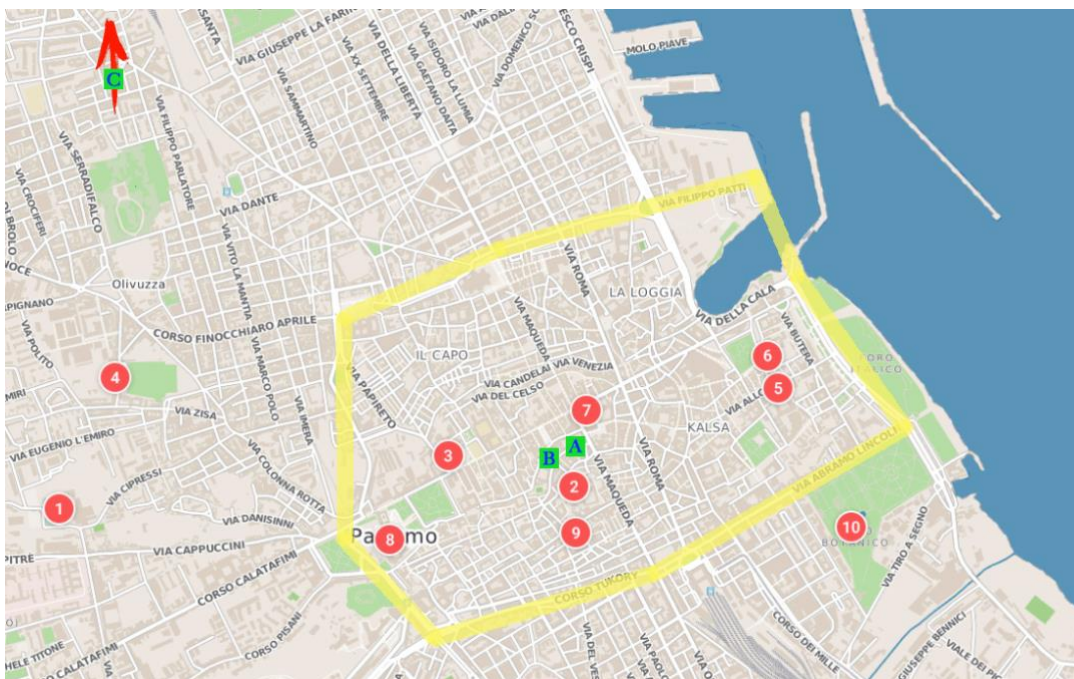
